Second Term For Sinai's Meltzer

Neil Meltzer, president and chief operating officer of Sinai Hospital and senior vice president of Life-Bridge Health, has been selected to serve a second three-year term on the U.S. Government Accountability Office's National Health Care Workforce Commission.

Meltzer was first appointed to the commission when it was formed in 2010. The commission makes recommendations to the president, Congress and state and local governments about health-care issues facing the country's workforce.
